register 4. Purpose of the personal data processing

As the data controller, BDO Group handles the following information management functions of BDO Group:

5. Data content of the register

Personal data concerning clients and employees:

- professional title and organisation as well as the position in the organisation
- possible authorisations, consents and offer prohibition data as well as other information collected with the person's consent.

6. Regular data sources

Information for this register is regularly obtained from HR and the persons themselves.

7. Regular disclosure of information

BDO does not regularly disclose personal data under this register notice to any third parties, except when required by Finnish authorities as set out in law, and to its software/system suppliers and other subcontractors for the purposes of use described above as well as to BDO Global in respect of AD.

8. Data transfer outside the EU or the EEA

9. Principles on how the register is protected
